



Florida Association for Food Protection Student Travel Scholarship

Objective:

To provide travel funding for full-time students to attend the Annual Meeting of the International Association for Food Protection to encourage education and networking for the advancement of food safety.

Application Submission Period:

February 1st through May 1st

Criteria:

- Be a Student or Full Member of FAFP
- Demonstrate interest in and commitment to food safety and quality as a student (undergraduate or graduate level) enrolled full-time in a Biological, Physical or Food Sciences, Hospitality Management or other food industry field
- Submit Application by May 1st that includes:
 - Completed Student Travel Application
 - Statement of Interest explaining:
 - Your career aspirations
 - Why you wish to attend the IAFP annual meeting
 - Your current research projects
 - Additional information to include:
 - List of received awards, honors, travel grants, scholarships, etc.
 - Schools attended
 - Involvement in FAFP or Student Chapter of FAFP
 - Other relevant supporting materials
 - Letter of recommendation from faculty member or department head

Additional Information for Application:

- Applicant is not required to present an oral or poster technical paper to qualify for the award
- Previous recipients of the scholarship are not eligible to apply

- Applications may be submitted to FAFP via mail or e-mail and must be postmarked by the deadline
- Application submitted in Microsoft Word or PDF

Travel Requirements

- Travel Scholarship is limited to \$1000 per student
- Travel is not transferable to another student or professor
- Recipient will make their own travel arrangements
- Receipts for travel should be submitted to FAFP for reimbursement after completion of travel
- Recipient is asked to submit a written summary of their experiences at the Annual Meeting by September 2nd for publication in an upcoming FAFP newsletter
